Established in 1962, Richland Medical Center is a full-service primary care clinic located in the same building as the Richland Hospital. The clinic provides services that surpass many which are twice its size. Richland Medical Center offers a variety of providers for patients including full-time specialists and specialists rotating from outside facilities from both the Madison and LaCrosse areas. The Center Creek Professional Building houses Richland Medical Center's MRI services and the Geriatric Center as well as leased space for dental and dialysis services.



Richland Medical Center has strong community ties and sponsors many annual and charitable events in the community. The physicians and staff are often visible at these events alongside their families and friends.

Rotation Experiences

Richland Medical Center has proudly been a rural rotation site since 1981. Experienced physicians offer a well-established Rural Family Medicine Rotation that is meant to be immersive, covering the breadth of what a rural family physician may cover with options of additional focus including:

- **Urgent Care**
- **Cardiac Stress Testing**

The rotation can be 4-6 weeks depending on availability and scheduling and housing can be arranged.
