WHAT IS A RESIDENCY PROGRAM?

Monroe Clinic's Residency Program trains physicians who have chosen to specialize in Family Medicine. Family Medicine physicians provide comprehensive and individualized care for all members of the family - men, women, children - through all ages and stages. Our resident physicians receive training in OB/Gyn, pediatrics, general surgery, and many other specialty areas.

WHAT IS A RESIDENT PHYSICIAN?

A resident physician is a physician-in-training who has graduated from an allopathic (MD) or osteopathic (DO) medical school. Residents spend three years of post-graduate training to learn family-centered care in a rural setting. Resident physicians are supervised by board-certified Monroe Clinic physicians.

HOW WILL THIS IMPACT PATIENTS?

If you schedule an appointment with one of our resident physicians, you can expect to receive the same quality care you've come to expect from our Family Medicine providers. Some patients may see two physicians, the new resident physician and the supervising physician, during their visit - at no additional charge.

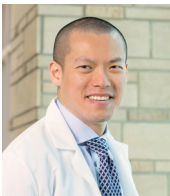
BRITTANY BLOMBERG, DO

Dr. Blomberg graduated from Des Moines University College of Osteopathic Medicine. She enjoys reading, crafting, Zumba, running and hiking.



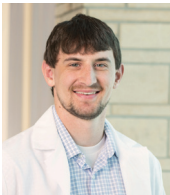
MARK BLOMBERG, DO

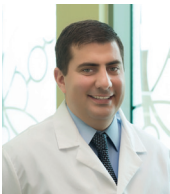
BENJAMIN CHAO, DO
